

## Internet bids farewell to the monopoly of the Latin alphabet

From the middle of next year will be online to use the Internet addresses in alphabets other than Latin - inform the representatives of American organizations of ICANN, which regulates matters related to internet domains. Informed about this on Tuesday, Russian Portal Grani.ru.

According to ICANN's introduction of a new system of Internet addresses will be most important change in the global network since its inception. Plans to grant web pages addresses using letters from other languages, non-Latin alphabets, approved in 2008. Since that time the work was carried out DNS resolver websites and their identification with existing IP addresses. How Peter Dengate Thrush said the authority of ICANN, this work has been successfully completed. "Grani.ru" notes that, especially Russia is counting on the emergence of addresses written in Cyrillic domain completed. "Rf" (Russian Federation). In some countries such as China or Thailand, you can now enter the names of the parties in the languages of those countries, but at the international level, these solutions are not considered. Such a way to enter the address may not work on all computers.
